Voyageurs Lutheran Ministry Alcohol Policy for Weddings and 100+ Events

Consumption of alcohol at Camp Hiawatha and Camp Vermilion is a privilege and not a right. Our staff and volunteers are required, by law and VLM Policy, to report any illegal activities, abuse or damage to local law enforcement authorities. A \$250 deposit is required in addition to any regular deposits. If no damage is found or no excessive clean-up is required, all but \$75 of the deposit will be refunded. Any costs above the full \$250 deposit incurred due to damage or additional housekeeping as a result of the consumption of alcohol will be the responsibility of the Group Contact Person.

1. Alcohol is permitted only in the buildings that are assigned to your group.
2. Types of Alcohol allowed:
 - a. Beer in Kegs or cans only; glass bottles are not allowed.
 - b. Wine and champagne
 - c. A limited bar or 2-4 specialty mixed drinks with a licensed bartender
3. Individuals who have consumed alcohol should not ~~to~~ use the waterfront, watercraft, or sauna.
4. No Alcohol is allowed in or near the Sauna.
5. Please consume in moderation and respect quiet hours.
6. Underage drinking, excessive drinking/abuse, and/or damage will not be tolerated.
7. VLM has the right to revoke this permission at any time and will contact the local law enforcement authorities to assist with any groups that are not in compliance.

By signing below, you also are completely relieving and absolving VLM of any responsibility or liability for any damages to person(s) or property or any injuries or death caused by anyone in your group who has consumed alcohol.
