



# Voyageurs Lutheran Ministry Wedding Policies/Guidelines for Camp Hiawatha and Camp Vermilion

The flat rate charge reserves the space for your event.

- Weekend rate of \$5000 includes access to the sauna, campfire rings, waterfront, and use of non-housing buildings.
- Day rate of \$2000 includes access to ceremony and reception space, as well as a place for the bridal party to dress. Other buildings or site space may be available, but are not guaranteed.
- The exact buildings and any outdoor spaces you plan to use must be finalized 30 days prior to your event.
- Housing and meal costs are in addition to this flat rate.

A cleaning/damage deposit of \$250 is required. This amount will be credited to the final balance if no damage or excessive cleaning is required after the event.

Alcohol deposit of \$250 is required. All but \$75 is credited to final balance if no damage or alcohol related issues happen.

Wedding Party must provide General Liability limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate, and name Voyageurs Lutheran Ministries as Additional Insured. Additionally, Host Liquor Liability Coverage is required if alcohol is to be served. 50% of the package rate as well as the cleaning and alcohol deposits are required with signed agreement and signed alcohol policy.

## Catering/Food Service:

- Use of our main commercial kitchen is not part of the use of the site for your event.
- Bridal party/family also does not have access to the camp's main kitchen refrigerators for alcohol, wedding cake/dessert, or other foods
- Refrigerators are available in the Bakk House (Vermilion) or Retreat Center (Hiawatha) along with small dorm size units in each dining hall.

Outside Caterers: must be self-contained in regards to preparation and clean up. Our buffet lines are available for serving.

- If your caterer cannot be self-contained and is requesting access to our kitchen then a conversation with the caterer and VLM staff needs to take place at least 6 months before the event before they would be approved to use our kitchen.
- Caterers will be expected to provide proof of food service license and food safe certification for any staff they plan to use. The Caterer must provide General Liability limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate, and name Voyageurs Lutheran Ministries as Additional Insured.
- If caterer is serving alcohol the certificate must reflect \$1,000,000 Liquor Liability.
- Additionally, an insurance Certificate reflecting Evidence of Workers Compensation Coverage is required.
- A tour of the facility with the caterer is required and a complete list of dishes and equipment they will need to use. There would also be an additional charge of \$1000 for this as we would require a VLM staff member to be in the kitchen with them.

# Catering provided by Camp staff:

- Meals are served buffet style.
- Weddings over 200 people must be approved by our food service staff before we agree to provide catering services.
- Numbers are required 3 weeks prior to the wedding date, and that is the number that will be billed to the couple.

Catering Rates: subject to change

Breakfast on Saturday and/or Sunday - \$10 per person

Continental breakfast option for \$5 per person

Brunch again on Saturday and/or Sunday - \$11 per person

Lunch - \$12 per person

Catered meal for **rehearsal dinner**, depending on the menu, would start at \$15 per person. Catered meal for **reception dinner**, depending on the menu, would start at \$20 per person.

children ages 4-11 are half price; 3 and under are free

#### Lodging

It is the responsibility of the couple or their designee to assign housing/take guest reservations. Guests should not call the camp to serve a cabin/room.

# Camp Hiawatha options:

- Retreat Center rented as a whole building. There is a full kitchen in this building, and any bridal party or family food should be kept here.
- Dorm Rooms \$115 per night. This rate assumes it is a family or group of friends using the cabin. If you have an individual or couple who would like their own room, the cost is \$44 per person per night.
- Tent or Camper \$18 per night for a tent; \$25 per night for a camper/small RV (we do have limited options for water and electric hookups, and cannot accommodate 30 amp needs.

# Camp Vermilion options:

- Voyageur Lodge the larger rooms that sleep 8-16 people are \$135 per room per night; the smaller room is usually rented at a per person rate, which would be \$52 per person per night. (If you happen to put 4 people in that room, we would do the per room rate instead; basically we go with what is cheaper)
- Bakk House rented as a whole building. There is a full kitchen in this building, and any bridal party or family food should be kept here.
- Summer cabins \$73 for one night; \$55 each additional night. This rate assumes it is a family or group of friends using the cabin. If you have an individual or couple who would like their own cabin, that rate is \$25 per night per person.
- Tent or camper \$18 per night for a tent; \$25 per night for a camper/small RV (we do have limited options for water and electric hookups, and cannot accommodate 30 amp needs.)

## **Other Important Notes:**

- Pets are not allowed at camp during wedding events. Certified service animals are the exception.
- If you are planning an outdoor wedding, you need to have a rain backup option. Camp buildings are an option but have limited capacity.
- Smoking is not permitted in ANY building or on wooden decks. We also ask that people remain 15 feet away from buildings when smoking.
- Camp canoes are not available to be used to hold beverages and ice.

**At Camp Hiawatha** - receptions need to be held indoors, as there is no amplified sound allowed outside after 7pm. This is a way we can be good neighbors to others on the lake.
